

## **Primary School Sports Premium Funding 2023/2024**

The government is providing funding of £150 million per annum to provide provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport – is allocated to primary school headteachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all children. The sports funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

### **Purpose of funding**

Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this. Possible uses for the funding might include:

- Hiring specialist teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with teachers when teaching PE.
- Supporting and engaging the least active children.
- Paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport.
- Providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport.
- Running sport competitions, or increasing pupils' participation in the School Games.
- Buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport.
- Providing places for pupils on after school sports clubs and holiday clubs.
- Pooling the additional funding with that of other local schools.
