

Google Classroom

To access Google Classroom, the children need to visit: edu.wonde.com (this can be done via computer, tablet, phone etc with internet access and is free to access).

Once on the website, the children need to 'search for their school', which is Ingrave Johnstone, or they can log in with their 'magic badge' (their QR code). The QR code needs to be held in front of a camera, if the device has one, and will begin to load the website afterwards.

If they search for the school, they will need to enter their username. Their username is their first name, followed by a full stop (.), followed by their surname – no spaces and in lowercase. For example, Joe Bloggs would be `joe.bloggs`. If they scan their QR code instead, it brings them on to the next page. QR codes can be found in their homework book.

They need to click on the Classroom icon (they may need to accept some terms and conditions, continue with the given email, and click that they are a student).

They then need to click on their current year group. Some children may need to click 'join' on their current year group.

They will see that their teacher has posted what to do – this is the Stream page. There are tabs along the top for Stream, Classwork and People.

The platform is intended for children to access online learning and homework - teachers will only be using the online platform for children's work. If you have anything you wish to discuss please do so via the usual channels.

Troubleshooting

If there is **more than one pupil** using the same device at home to access Google Classroom:

These instructions are for logging one pupil out of their account, and logging another pupil into their account.

Whilst in the Google Classroom where they can see their class Stream (where their teacher has posted), they need to click in the top right corner, where there is the first initial letter of their first name. Click on this letter, scroll down to 'sign out' and click on it.

This should bring you back to the initial log in screen (where you previously selected Classroom). This time in the top right corner again, click 'logout' next to the pupil's name.

Close the tab. If there is another 'edu wonde' homepage open, click 'logout' in the top right corner. If there are any other open tabs, you need to log out of every one.

The next pupil (sibling) should then be able to log in with their details.

Whilst we appreciate that it can be easier to save passwords on devices for future logins, if pupils have siblings then we recommend not saving passwords on the device, and instead logging out and back in in between each pupil using the device.

Prompted for a Google Classroom code

If you are prompted to enter a classroom code to join the classroom then you are logged into the browser with a Gmail account logged in. You need to logout of the Gmail account or use a different browser where Gmail is not logged in.

For the safety and security of our students we restrict all external accounts from accessing the classrooms. If you are already logged in to a Gmail account, Google settings use these rather than the student account which prompts for a code.

No Users Data Found

If you scan the QR code with your camera a message "No Users Data Found". Please navigate to edu.wonde.com and search for the school. From here click on the "Magic Badge" option and scan the QR code to login.

Problems using Chrome Books

Google Chrome settings on Chrome Books are very restrictive for a child's account. Please login with a normal (not child's account) to the chrome book and download the Firefox app (anything other than chrome). Open Firefox (the new browser) then type edu.wonde.com in the url and login as your child.
